- 2 Cahrbik Kashyab, a shining star from Class X B, secures an impressive 2nd International Rank in the SOF International Social Olympiad. Congratulations on this outstanding achievement!
- 3 Prerana Sharma, an exceptional student from Class XI (INT. SC.), demonstrates brilliance by achieving excellence in SOF Olympiad exams in 4 subjects scoring highest cumulative marks. (Social Science, Mathematics, Science and Cyber Olympiad). A total of 260 students were selected from across the globe out of which she is one.
